Breakfast Club and After School Wraparound Care Club

Breakfast Club is available for all children at Fishtoft Academy, entry from 8 am - 8.15 am and the charge is £1.00 per day per child. Free from April 2026.

After School Wraparound Care is £4.00 per session per child between 3.15 pm and 5 pm with collection from the school hall.

ILLNESS
