EYFS - Summer Term I

Reading

You must read at least 4 times a week at home. Each time ask an adult to log this on Boom Reader — log in provided in homework book.

Complete by: 30.4.25 Writing Task

Write instructions on how to make your favourite simple meal. Have a go at writing this yourself before getting an adult to help you.

Challenge

Can you write a thank you card to someone that has done something nice for you? The thank you card might be for cooking a meal, giving you a present etc.

Stick your card in your book.

Complete by: 7.5.25 Maths Task

Practice writing your numbers from 0-20 in your book. Have a go at writing this yourself before getting an adult to help you.

Challenge

Grow a plant at home. Take a picture or draw a picture of what your plant looks like for the next five weeks as it grows. Tip — you can get seeds from the fruits and vegetables you eat at home.

Challenge

Research what old toys children used to play with in the 1800s and 1900s.
Stick pictures in your books or draw pictures of the toys you find.

Challenge

Write a list of what makes a good friend.

Phonics

Practice your phonics sounds with your adults at home. You can do this by looking at the sounds in your reading books, or you can log on to EdShed (log in provided in front cover of homework book).

Challenge

Make a healthy recipe with an adult at home. Take pictures of your finished product or write the recipe in your homework book.

Challenge

Draw a picture of your favourite fruits and vegetables in your homework book.

Complete by: 14.5.25 Topic Task

Draw the life cycle of a butterfly in your homework book.

Challenge

Make a fruit salad at home with all of your favourite fruits. Take a picture of your finished product, or draw a picture of your finished product, and write the recipe in your book.

Complete by: 21.5.25 Writing Task

Write a simple description of your favourite person and draw a picture to match. Have a go at writing this yourself before getting an adult to help you.

Challenge

Draw a picture of your friends in your homework book.

Number Facts

Practice counting to 20.

Year 1 & Year 2 - Summer Term 1

Reading

Complete by: 30.4.25 Writing Task

Write a description of someone in your house. Don't forget to include the descriptive language we have been learning about in class. i.e., alliteration, expanded noun phrases.

Challenge

Create a fact file about Joseph Banks. Research information such as what did he achieve in his life, when was he born etc.

Complete by: 7.5.25 Maths Task

Use objects/food/paper at home to practice splitting things into one third and one quarter.

Draw what you have shared equally into your homework book.

Challenge

Make a sailing ship at home out of scrap materials or rubbish from around your home. Draw a picture of your ship or take photos and stick them into your homework book. Bring the ship in to show the class.

Challenge

Make a adventurer themed meal or dessert with an adult at home. This can be as creative as you like. Take a photo of your meal or draw a picture of your finished product.

Challenge

Can you write a diary entry of a sailor on a voyage?

Spelling/Phonics

Every Friday you will receive spellings to be learnt for a test on the following Friday. These spellings will be in line with the sounds learnt during our spellings/phonics lessons.

Challenge

Can you practice writing the numbers to 100 in your books.

Challenge

Draw a clock in your homework book. Around the clock write the times that the minute hand would be showing if it landed on each number.

Complete by: 14.5.25 PSHE Task

Draw a picture of you in the middle of the page. Around you, on the page, draw all of your favourite things.

Challenge

Have a look at the plants in your garden or plant a seed.

Observe the plant or seed over two weeks and see how the plant grows. Draw how the plant changes over the two weeks.

Complete by: 21.5.25 Design and Technology Challenge

Can you make a smoothie or fruit salad at home? Take a photo or draw a picture of your finished product in your homework book.
