## Our Curriculum

### Maths:

In maths this term the children will be learning about:

- Multiplying up to a 4-digit number by a 2-digit number
- Long division
- Mental strategies
- Adding and Subtracting Fractions (Revisit)
- Decimal numbers

Every week we will have an Arithmetic test, providing an excellent opportunity for the learners to compete with themselves to better their scores and to challenge themselves.

Year 6 will also have an extra maths session each week to prepare for the SAT's examinations in May.

### Times tables :

This year, we will continue to focus on times tables. It was a government expectation that by the end of Year 4, all children should know their times table and division facts up to and including  $12 \times 12$ .

Throughout the year, the children will continue to be tested on their times tables to further boost/secure their knowledge and also give them an opportunity to earn their times tables certificates.

### **English:**

In English this term, we will begin by writing a setting description based on 'Letters from the Lighthouse' by Emma Carrol set during World War 2. We will then move on to write a Narrative with Speech about an Evacuee meeting their new family for the first time. By the end of the term, the class will have also studied formal reports and persuasive posters, to write their own persuasive speech.

To help develop the children's spelling, we use Spelling Shed. This program has fantastic games/resources to help the children practice their weekly spellings. The children will be given assignments every week based on a spelling rule and will then be tested in class on that rule the following week.

### **Science**

In Science the children will be learning about Forces. The children will be learning about:

- What is gravity?
- What is friction?
- What is air resistance?

- What is water resistance?
- Gears, Pulleys and Levers.

**Topic:**

Our Topic for the term is World War 2. The children will be learning about:

- To construct a basic timeline to sequence events
- To know what events happened in the lead up to World War 2.
- To know how Germany has changed from the 1900's to today.
- To know how World War 2 began.
- To understand how/why Britain reacted to the war.
- To know how life changed in Britain during the war.
- To know what the Home Front was and how they coped under attack.

### Boom Reader

### Homework

Homework will be set on a Friday and is due in the following Wednesday. The homework is always fully explained to the children and often recaps things they have been learning in class. The children will be sent home with a copy of the pick and mix grid which has the homework for the term on (this is also available on the school's website). If there are any issues or problems with the homework, please don't hesitate to get in touch.

### **Water Bottles**

Please ensure that water bottles contain only water as squash and fizzy drinks are not permitted in the classroom. We also ask that all water bottles are named so the children can easily identify theirs and that they are plastic. Glass bottles are not permitted in school.

### **PlusPay**

Fishtoft Academy is a cashless school. To support this, we use an app called PlusPay to pay for a range of things in school (Breakfast/Afterschool club, Trips etc.). If you have any issues throughout the year with PlusPay, please see Mrs Bringeman.

### **MyEd**

Please keep an eye on MyEd as any important information, notices and letters will be posted on the app. We will also post some of the amazing work the children have been doing in class and celebrate some of their successes through our social media platforms. ### **Carrot Rewards**

Children can earn a range of certificates based on the amount of Carrot Reward points they earn and at the end of every term the 10 highest earners will win special certificates to celebrate their hard work.
