EYFS – Summer Term 2

This 'Pick and Mix' homework is for the whole half term. **Red** Boxes need to be completed regularly each week. **Yellow** Boxes must be done at some point during the half term. Challenge yourself to the **green** box activities. These do not have to be done, but if you want to push yourself, that would be super!

Reading

You must read at least 4 times a week at home. Each time ask an adult to log this on Boom Reader – log in provided in homework book.

Complete by: 11.6.25

Writing Task

Can you write a story about a person who goes on holiday in your homework book? What adventures will they go on? What will they see?

Challenge

Make a meal or dessert using ingredients that are grown locally to where you live. Take a picture of your product and stick it in your book or write the recipe in your book.

Complete by: 18.6.25

Maths Task

Play a game of snap at home. You can do this with playing cards or write numbers on pieces of paper to match up. Draw a picture of the winner in your book.

Challenge

Draw a picture of your favourite place to go on holiday. Label the picture with the name of your favourite place to go on holiday and write a simple sentence telling me why it is your favourite.

Challenge

Try camping at home! Set up a camping space inside or outside. Don't forget your teddy bear! Take pictures and stick them in your book or draw a picture of your camping space.

Maths Task

Roll a dice at home. Find double of the number it lands on. Do this five times.

Phonics

Practice your phonics sounds with your adults at home. You can do this by looking at the sounds in your reading books, or you can log on to EdShed (log in provided in front cover of homework book).

Challenge

In class, we will be reading and exploring the book 'The Lighthouse Keeper's Lunch'. Can you make a lunch fit for a lighthouse keeper? Take a picture of your finished product or draw a picture of it in your book.

Complete by: 2.7.25

Topic Task

Make a model airplane at home. You can use recycled materials that you can find around your home.

Complete by: 9.7.25

Topic Task

Research old and new airplanes. Draw a picture of the old and new airplanes in your book. Write two sentences to tell me how the transport has changed.

Challenge

In this term, the season will be changing to summer! Go outside, write a list and draw pictures of the seasonal changes you can see outside.

Writing Task

Take a look out of your window, pick an object and write a sentence about it in your book. Do this three times.

Challenge

Can you design and label a spaceship fit for an alien? Draw your design in your homework book and label all the great features that your spaceship has.

Number Facts

Practice counting to 20 in numerals and words.

Writing Task

Write a story about a person who goes on an expedition to the North Pole. What adventures will they go on? What will they see?

Spelling/Phonics

Every Friday you will receive spellings to be learnt for a test on the following Friday. These spellings will be in line with the sounds learnt during our spellings/phonics lessons.

Challenge

Can you write a story about someone exploring a mysterious cave?

History Task

Research a famous explorer. Write a fact file about their life and expeditions.

Science Task

Draw and label the food chain of an animal in your book.

Challenge

In this term, the season will be changing to summer! Go outside and see what seasonal changes you can observe. Draw pictures and label them showing the seasonal changes that you have found.

Art Challenge

Make a sculpture using paper at home by folding and gluing the paper and recycled materials.

Challenge

Make a weather calendar in your homework book by drawing a grid in your book. Fill in the weather that you can observe for one week.
