Please take time to share our curriculum letter with your household and enjoy a chance to see what your child/children will be doing at school this term. Children will need PE kits in school for PE sessions and interhouse lunchtimes sports, so it is recommended that children bring their kits to school on Monday and leave at school until the end of the week.

In English we shall be sharing the text Breaker all about a pair of children who have a mission to complete involving an oil spill and a very strange professor. We shall create a news report, narrative dialogue, and persuasive texts.



In Maths we shall be exploring decimal numbers, place value, shapes and angles, and patterns in numbers. TT Rockstars and Numbots are encouraged at home and school to reinforce number fact knowledge and quick recall.



<u>In Spelling</u> we shall continue to work on our Ed Shed spellings with a range of games and activities each week linked to the set spellings for your child's group.

At home use of the games is on the class's homework to support the "little but often" approach to the learning of key words and spelling rules.



In Science we shall be investigating how our body works with a focus on circulation and the heart. We shall find out all about blood and what keeps our bodies healthy.



In Humanities we shall be finding out about our role as caretakers of the Earth with a focus on the damage caused to nature by mankind and how we are trying to solve these problems as well as researching different areas of the world.
