




Dear parents and carers,

Please take time to share our curriculum letter with your household and enjoy a chance to see what your child/ children will be doing at school this term. We have a busy and fun filled term full of activities and learning experiences.

<p><u>English</u></p> <p>Our written work this term will be based on a fabulous film unit called Girl and Robot. TT Rockstars and Numbots are encouraged at home and school to reinforce number fact knowledge and quick recall.</p> <p><u>Year 4</u> will be taking part in the Multiplication Check. We kindly ask that you continue to support your child with their times tables learning at home.</p>	<p><u>Spelling</u></p> <p>We shall continue to work on our Ed Shed spellings with a range of games and activities each week linked to the set spellings for your child's group.</p> <p>At home use of the games is on the class's homework to support the "little but often" approach to the learning of key words and spelling rules.</p>
<p><u>Science</u></p> <p>During this unit of work, children will explore simple pushes and pulls as an introduction to forces. They will explore how the texture of an object or the surface it is on can affect how the object moves. They will then explore pushes and pulls further by investigating different magnets and how they can pull (attract) and push (repel) at a distance without contact.</p>	<p><u>Computing</u></p> <p>This term we will be learning to use I-movie.</p> <p><u>Computer Science- coding</u> Year 3 will be looking at debugging movement. Year 4 will be designing a computer game</p> <p><u>Internet Safety</u> Children will be looking how to manage their online information.</p>	<p><u>Humanities</u></p> <p>Our area of study this term is the 'Active Planet'. <p><u>PE</u></p> <p>PE sessions will remain on Tuesdays and Thursdays. Children will need to arrive in school in school uniform.
