## ATTENDANCE

### ILLNESS

If your child is unable to attend school because they are unwell, this must be communicated to school before 8.50 am by telephone or by messaging via MyEd. You will need to inform us of your child's name and the reason for their absence including the symptoms. If your child is absent for more than one day, then you must report the absence for each day of illness.
